Procedures for Waiting in the Hall for Mr. Ross

- If you're asked to leave the classroom because of a behavior or procedure violation, it's so that Mr. Ross can speak to you privately.
- When asked to leave, leave quietly. Making a scene doesn't make things better, only worse.
- Go directly to the table and chairs in the hall to the right of the classroom. Take a seat.
- As soon as possible, Mr. Ross will come out and talk to you. If you're ready, Mr. Ross will bring you back in. occasionally, Mr. Ross will send a student to retrieve you. It's important that you return at that time.
- Never leave the table and chairs area to go anywhere, to the office or even to the bathroom. Going outside to make a cell phone call without permission is a blatant violation of school policy.
- Most important: Following Mr. Ross' classroom policy and procedures will assure that you will never get sent from the classroom. That's the best solution.
